1. SPORTING REGULATIONS - GENERAL

1.1. Title & Jurisdiction

The **BRITISH WOMEN RACING DRIVERS' CLUB AUTOCROSS AND RALLYCROSS CHAMPIONSHIP** is administered by the **BRITISH WOMEN RACING DRIVERS' CLUB (BWRDC)** in accordance with the General Championship Prescriptions of the **Royal Automobile Club Motor Sports Association (MSA)** and these Championship Regulations.

Event Status: Clubmans, National B, National A and International.

MSA Championship Grade: Not Applicable

1.3. Competitor Eligibility

1.3.1. Entrants must be fully paid up valid membership card holding Full or Associate members of the BWRDC and in possession of a current valid MSA Entrants Licence.

1.3.2. Drivers and Entrant/Drivers must be fully paid up valid membership card holding members of the BWRDC, be registered for the Championship and be in possession of a valid MSA Competition (Speed or Racing) Licence, or being in possession of a valid licence and medical issued by the ASN of a member country of the European Union

1.3.3. Club membership will be checked by the Co-ordinator, MSA licence validity will assumed to have been checked by event organisers.

1.4. Registration

1.4.1. Fully paid up members of the BWRDC are assumed to be registered from the date their membership application or renewal is received by the membership Secretary.

1.4.2. There is no additional registration fee.

1.4.3. The Championship claim period is from 1st December until the 30th November of each year.

1.4.4. There are no registration numbers.

1.5. Championship Rounds

All Autocrosses and Rallycrosses run under MSA permits, the FIA or their appointed ASN for International events, will be eligible.

1.6. Scoring

1.6.1. Points will be awarded to competitors listed as classified finishers in the Final Results allocated as per schedule plus:

- 1 point for starting
- 2 points for starting a National A Status event.
- 3 points for starting an International Status event.
- 1 point for overall fastest time of the day.

Where two or more classes are amalgamated the points schedule may only be applied to the numbers of starters and the finish position within the claimant's original class.

1.6.2. The best 6 results will count. Claims must be made on the appropriate forms for each specified period and must be accompanied by the official results (which will be returned if a s.a.e. is supplied). Claim forms must reach the Co-ordinator not later than 5 days after each period end date. Any claim received after this date will not be accepted, unless a certificate of posting is provided as proof of posting date.

1.6.3. Claim Periods are: **31st May, 31st July, 30th September and 30th November.**

1.6.4. Where result sheets are not available, written confirmation, signed by a Steward, Clerk of the Course or Secretary of the Meeting, stating the event status, number of starters and final class position will be accepted.

1.6.5. Ties will be resolved by the highest number of best results

1.7. Awards

1.7.1. All awards are to be provided by the BWRDC, who reserve the right to withhold any award if the Organisers feel that there has been insufficient support.

1.7.2. No awards will be given for any individual event.

1.7.3. A Trophy will be awarded to the highest points scorer, this award is perpetual and will be held for 11 months.

1.7.4. Any sponsorship money received will be divided between Competitors either by position or pro-rata on points claimed.

1.7.5. The Awards will be presented at an Annual Dinner to be held between 30th November and 31st March of each year.

1.7.6. Entertainment Tax Liability - not applicable

1.7.7. Title to all Trophies: In the event of any Provisional Results or Championship Tables being revised after any provisional presentations and such revisions affect the distribution of any awards, the Competitors concerned must return such awards to the BWRDC in good condition within 7 days.

2. SPORTING REGULATIONS - JUDICIAL PROCEDURES

Rounds: In accordance with the current MSA Competitors and Officials Yearbook and the individual event organisers.

Championship: In accordance with the current MSA Competitors and Officials Yearbook.

In accordance with the Supplementary Regulations of the individual events

4. CHAMPIONSHIP EVENT PENALTIES

As per the current MSA Judicial Procedure Regulations.

5. TECHNICAL REGULATIONS

Vehicles must be eligible for the event in which they are entered, and conform to that events technical regulations.
