1. SPORTING REGULATIONS - GENERAL

1.1. Title & Jurisdiction

The **BRITISH WOMEN RACING DRIVERS' CLUB RACING CHAMPIONSHIP** is administered by the **BRITISH WOMEN RACING DRIVERS' CLUB (BWRDC)** in accordance with the General Championship Prescriptions of the **Royal Automobile Club Motor Sports Association (MSA)** and these Championship Regulations.

RAC Championship Permit No: Not Applicable

Race Status: Clubmans, National B, National A and International.

MSA Championship Grade: Not Applicable

1.3. Competitor Eligibility

1.3.1. Entrants must be fully paid up valid membership card holding members of the BWRDC and in possession of a current valid MSA Entrants Licence.

1.3.2. Drivers and Entrant/Drivers must be fully paid up valid membership card holding members of the BWRDC, be registered for the Championship and be in possession of a valid MSA Competition (Racing) Licence, either being eligible to hold, or holding a licence of National A or higher Grade, or be in possession of a valid licence and medical issued by the ASN of a member country of the European Union

1.3.3. Club membership will be checked by the Co-ordinator, MSA licence validity will assumed to have been checked by event organisers.

1.4. Registration

1.4.1. Fully paid up members of the BWRDC are assumed to be registered from the date their membership application or renewal is received by the membership Secretary.

1.4.2. There is no additional registration fee.

1.4.3. The Championship claim period is from 1st December to 30th November

1.4.4. There are no registration numbers.

1.5. Championship Rounds

All races run under MSA permits, the FIA or their appointed ASN for International events, will be eligible with the following provisos:

- Points may be claimed from any number of races competed in on the same day.
- A heat will qualify for points, providing the competitor can provide proof that the heat received prizes.
- Handicap races will qualify if in excess of 6 laps or 12 miles.
- Invitation and celebrity races, or races which are an integral part of a competition that covers other forms of motor sport, will not be accepted.

1.6. Scoring

1.6.1. Points will be awarded to competitors listed as classified finishers in the final results, allocated as per the points table plus:

- 1 point for starting
- 1 point for finishing
- 2 additional points for finishing a Championship race.
- 3 additional points for finishing a National A Status race.
- 4 additional points for finishing a International Status race.
- 2 points for fastest lap in class or race (min 3 starters)

Double the schedule points will be awarded for long distance races in which the driver covers over 100 miles.

1.6.2. Where a race is run in classes, the points schedule may only be applied to the numbers of starters and the finish position within the claimant's original class.

1.6.3. The best 10 results will count. Claims must be made on the appropriate forms for each specified period and must be accompanied by the official results (which will be returned if a s.a.e. is supplied). Claim forms must reach the Co-ordinator not later than 5 days after each period end date. Any claim received after this date will not be accepted, unless a certificate of posting is provided as proof of posting date.

The Claim Periods are: **31st May, 31st July, 30th September and 30th November.**

1.6.4. Ties will be resolved by the highest number of best results

1.7. Awards

1.7.1. All awards are to be provided by the BWRDC, who reserve the right to withhold any award if the Committee feel that there has been insufficient support.

1.7.2. No awards will be given for any individual event.

1.7.3. The Championship awards are perpetual and will be held for 11 months;

- The Goodwin Silver Trophies for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places will be awarded to the 3 highest Championship points scorers.

- The Jean Denton Newcomers Award will be awarded to the highest placed Competitor in their first year of full membership.

- The Monoposto Cup to be awarded to the highest placed Competitor in a single seater racing car

- The Jamieson Trophy will be awarded for the fastest lap, provided that the driver has competed in a minimum of two events in that car.

- The Hillwood Jewellers Coupe des Dames will be awarded to the driver with the highest number of class or outright wins and lap records.

- Additional awards may be given at the organisers discretion.

1.7.4. Any sponsorship money received will be divided between Competitors either by Championship position or pro-rata on points claimed.

1.7.5. Awards will be presented at an Annual Dinner to be held between 30th November and 31st March of each year.

1.7.6. Entertainment Tax Liability - not applicable

1.7.7. Title to all Trophies: In the event of any Provisional Results or Championship Tables being revised after any provisional presentations and such revisions affect the distribution of any awards, the Competitors concerned must return such awards to the BWRDC in good condition within 7 days.

Rounds: In accordance with the current MSA Yearbook and the individual event organisers.

Championship: In accordance with the current MSA Yearbook.

3. SPORTING REGULATIONS - CHAMPIONSHIP RACE MEETINGS & RACE PROCEDURES

In accordance with the Supplementary Regulations of the individual event

4. CHAMPIONSHIP RACE PENALTIES

As per MSA Judicial Procedure Regulations.

5. TECHNICAL REGULATIONS

Vehicles must be eligible for the event in which they are entered, and conform to that events technical regulations.

6.2. Commercial Undertakings: - Members must display BWRDC cloth badges on their overalls and Championship contender stickers on the competing vehicle.

6.3. Qualification Races: None.

6.4. Conversion of kilometres to miles is divide by 0.625

6.5. Lap speed is distance (miles) divided by time (seconds) multiplied by 3600
